Dear Lewis and Clark Conference Board,





Proposal: Secretary Pay

Rationale: Pay increase for position responsibilities

Variance in different conferences-

- Officer rotation and duties
- Length and number of meetings
- Number of schools in conference

Ranges in pay-

- 0- \$2,700
- Rotate with President duties

Job Duties -

-Maintaining website, create agendas and minutes, calendar and scheduling events, VB and BB Rosters for regular season, creating and posting forms for conference events, conference tournament correspondence and brackets, maintain conference records, award winners, maintaining rotation schedule, etc.

Secretary current pay is \$200.00 and \$100.00 for creating the conference volleyball tournament programs, boys and girl's tournament programs. (Before Kristie started creating the programs in 2008-2009 school year we paid Coleridge Blade \$356.18, VB program and \$506.18, boys and girls conference tournament programs a total of \$862.36 per year).

Proposing- \$450 secretary pay per year and leave the \$100 for programs as is. Total for the year would be \$550.00.
